90th Jubilee Scholarship Trust

In 1991 a group of former students organised a reunion to celebrate 90 years of education at Timaru College, Timaru Technical College and Mountainview High School. The 90th Jubilee was well attended and turned an unexpected profit. The organising committee, wanting to see this profit put to good use, so established a trust to provide scholarships for Mountainview High School students going on to tertiary study. The 90th Jubilee scholarship was awarded each year to a deserving individual who showed great potential while facing challenges in attending further study.

Ten years later, when the the 100 year celebrations took place, additional funds were raised to grow the value of scholarship. The scholarship continued to be awarded each year for over 25 years.

In 2019 the trustees were facing a perfect storm of diminishing interest rates, increasing compliance and trouble finding new trustees. It was then that they turned to the Aoraki Foundation for help.

In June 2019 the 90th Jubilee Scholarship formally transferred their funds to the Aoraki Foundation to establish the Mountainview High School Scholarship Fund. This fund will uphold the legacy started by the 90th Jubilee committee and continue to award annual scholarships in perpetuity.

The first challenge is to build the capital of the fund up to \$50,000. This threshold allows the scholarship to be of significant value each year while also providing a solid base to ensure it will continue long into the future.
