Multiple Sclerosis (MS) is an auto-immune disease where the immune system mistakenly attacks parts of the body that are vital to everyday function. Symptoms are unpredictable and can vary in intensity.

While some people experience fatigue and numbness, severe cases of MS can cause paralysis, vision loss, and diminished brain function.

MS can be a debilitating disease and there isn't the same wrap-around services as for the more prevalent diseases, making it especially important that members have the help of their local society to help them access agencies and services, they may not be aware of.

South Canterbury Multiple Sclerosis Society provide a wide range of services which include arranging social networking opportunities, one on one support, referrals to agencies and attending specialist appointments with members.
